Why We're Here

- 2030 SAME Strategic Plan
 - Goal: Develop People to Strengthen America's STEM Pipeline and Technical Workforce
 - "Promote a structured mentoring continuum, highlighting professional growth and leadership opportunities for members at all ages and experience levels."
 - Desired Outcome: Optimize SAME's human capital programs, Posts, and Regions to maintain and enrich the STEM pipeline by introducing youth to the industry and enhancing personal and professional growth of those already in the profession."
- National Leadership Opportunities Webinar initiated in 2020 to:
 - Increase size and diversity of SAME Key Leader Position (KLP) candidates
 - Ensure consistent pipeline of interested, qualified candidates for SAME KLPs
 - Help members navigate their SAME "career" by gaining and applying a diverse set of experiences
 - Demystify KLP requirements, expectations, and selection process

- Level of Commitment: Two-year term (w/third year option); approx. 100 hours/year for meetings, planning, and attendance at national SAME events
- Value & Benefits: Personal growth, professional leadership experience, industry visibility, and an opportunity to advance SAME in the A/E/C profession
- How to Volunteer: Lots of ways! Contact C3 Chair and let them know you want to step up into a leadership position. Chair-Elect typically selected six months prior to transition year JETC

- Description: Provide the critical link in communication, mentorship, and guidance between National Leadership & Direction, National Office, and SAME Post leaders
- **Key Leadership Experience:** Active member of Society; held at least one Post leadership position; positive working relationships w/industry, military, government civilians and Sustaining Member firms
- Level of Commitment: Two-year term (w/third year option); 1-4 hours per week plus periodic travel to Post events (SAME covers some travel expenses), and attendance at annual JETC and SBC.
- Value & Benefits: Industry viability; leadership development; career development; opportunity to enhance SAME's mission as member of the National Leadership Assembly
- How to Volunteer: Contact Post President or current RVP; RVP will recommend a candidate from the Region to the Post Presidents for a vote



National Elected Director

- **Description:** Shape the present and future of the Society by attending National Leadership Assembly(NLA) meetings, engaging in discussions, and supporting SAME Strategic Plan development and implementation
- Experience Requirement: Must have contributed to a Post and the Strategic Plan
- **Key Leadership Experience:** SAME is looking for a broad range of SAME and professional experience for Elected Directors great opportunity for initial exposure to the SAME NLA. Helpful if nominee has experience sitting on any other boards (SAME or not).
- Level of Commitment: Three-year term w/NLA meetings twice a year before JETC and SBC; will also be asked to serve on a National Task Force or Working Group
- Value & Benefits: Opportunity to serve on the NLA for a 24K+ member professional organization! Professional development, network building and national exposure
- **How to Volunteer:** Nominations due 1 Dec (https://www.same.org/about-same/governance-policies/national-leadership-nominations/); nominations can be by self or Post Presidents, NLA Members, National Officers, and SAME Foundation Board

At least one National Elected Director each year will be a Young Professional!!!

SAME Treasurer

- **Description:** The Treasurer provides volunteer financial oversite on behalf of the NLA and BOD. The Treasurer should have a thorough knowledge and understanding of the organization's financial reports and keep the board apprised of key financial events, trends, and concerns in coordination with the Executive Director and appropriate National Office Staff. The Treasurer will serve as a non-voting ex-officio member of the SAME Foundation Board of Directors and as a member of the Investment Committee. The Treasurer will serve as Audit Committee Chair for the annual audit.
- Experience Requirement: While currently there are no specific requirements for this position, it is helpful if this person has served on other not for profit boards. Ideally, this person would have a cursory understanding of GAAP as well as an ability to critically examine and present monthly balance sheets and income statements.
- **Key Leadership Experience:** While currently there are no specific requirements, past relevant experience may include: serving as a Post-Treasurer, having been part of the National Audit or Investment Committees, P&L and budget responsibility for a business unit within a larger organization, C-level experience with fiduciary responsibility with a large or small company, or a degree in accounting or finance.
- Level of Commitment: Considered a National Officer and member of the Executive Committee, Board of Direction, National Leadership Assembly, Investment Committee, and Foundation Board.
- Value & Benefits: Gain experience serving at the national level with the Executive Committee, as well as the ability to work closely with the National Staff. Could become an unofficial path toward President-Elect.
- How to Volunteer: Currently, the Treasurer is appointed by the President and approved by the NLA for a three-year term and may be reappointed for one additional term. Interested individuals can contact Jordan Beard, Jim Carter, or Kathy Off for more information. This position may become an elected position in the future.

SAME Foundation



- Founded in 2016....serves as the philanthropic arm of the Society.
- Underwrites leadership and mentoring programs keystone program is LDP.
 - Programs must support the Foundation's purpose: Fostering Engineering Leadership for the Nation.
- Primary job of board members and volunteers is to FUNDRAISE.
- **Key Leadership Experience:** Fundraising experience is highly desired. Society familiarity is encouraged (i.e. experience with the programs the Foundation supports is a positive). Other non-profit board experience a plus.
- Level of Commitment: Three-year term with option to extend for second term; approx. 100-200 hours/year.
 - Budget/Finance, Operations, and Fundraising Committees
- Value & Benefits: Unique and rewarding personal and professional opportunity. Help shape the future of our profession and give back to The Society. Tangible link to "fostering engineering leadership."
- **How to Volunteer:** Nominations typically open in July/August and due 31 August. Announced to the membership.
 - Selections are made in September and new Board members start in January.
 - No self-nominations. If not "ready" for a full Board commitment, consider being a Board volunteer; provides an opportunity for interested members to demonstrate their abilities prior to submitting a nomination.

- Level of Commitment: Three-year commitment (President-Elect: 400-500 hours/year; President: 1000-1100 hours/year; Past President: 250-400 hours/year)

- Experience Requirement: SAME Fellow
- Key Leadership Experience: Active leadership within SAME and demonstrated contributions, outcomes, and success at the Post and Regional levels; a demonstrated commitment to SAME.
- Level of Commitment: Three-year term; approx. 100 hours/year (busiest time is Nov-Dec around nomination review time).
- Value & Benefits: Opportunity to be an active player in the process for the only requirement to become President (SAME Fellow)!
- How to Volunteer: Contact anybody on the AOF Executive Committee on the Fellows web page: https://www.same.org/membership-communities/academy-of-fellows/. Positions include Deputy, Vice Chair Internal, Vice Chair Engagement, Vice Chair Events, Vice Chair Communications & Marketing, Vice Chair Mentoring, Vice Chair Awards & Recognition.

Myth Busters - Revisited

- There's no way I have the time or experience to be a SAME Regional or National Leader.
 - FALSE! SAME Regional and National Leadership positions are available to interested members with a wide range of availability and experience.
- You have to "know someone" to be chosen for SAME Key Leadership Positions.
 - FALSE! Nomination/selection process for SAME KLPs is fair and transparent. We celebrate interest from a broad range of SAME volunteer leaders!
- SAME has a "smoke filled room" where "SAME regulars" hand-pick Regional and National Leaders.
 - FALSE! SAME is <u>smoke-free</u>, dedicated to developing leaders and focused on a fair, transparent leadership selection process. But we need your help to get the word out!
- SAME Key Leadership Positions are reserved for engineers and retired military officers.
 - FALSE! SAME values/celebrates a diversity of perspective and experience for all KLPs!
- SAME Key Leadership Positions aren't open to Young Professionals (<40 years old).
 - FALSE! Young Professions are eligible for ALL SAME leadership positions; additionally, at least one Elected Director per year must be a Young Professional.
- I can't just nominate myself for Elected Director or a Society Leadership Position.
 - FALSE! Self-nominations are welcome for ALL SAME leadership Positions except the Foundation Board.
- You must have served as a Society Vice President to be eligible for President-Elect.
 - FALSE! The only requirement to become President-Elect is to be a Fellow.
- You must be a Fellow to serve on the Foundation.
 - FALSE! While it is not required to be a Fellow to serve on the Foundation, it IS a great way to contribute to the Society and add to a Fellows nomination form!

Final Thoughts...

- Never turn down a volunteer...find them the right opportunity!
- Actively seek out your replacement and future replacements...most people just need to be asked
- Development happens at every level...map the path to President!
- Diversify your search actively seek out folks outside your bubble
- Challenge Young Professionals to lead early and often!
- Deliberate development & succession planning are the key to maintaining momentum
